

- 1. Put your name down that you are interested in going.
- 2. Pay the \$30-40 for Nashville (depending on when you pay) (nonrefundable except in the case for sickness or family emergency). Checks made to "Cabot church of Christ", or Cash in an envelope with your name on it.
- 3. Finish the "Nashville Mission Trip Prep" book. Can be found up in Teen Center or welcome center.
- 4. Help Out with VBS teaching (because we are doing the same stories for Nashville) or set up some other prep with T. J. beforehand.
- 5. Turn in Rules sheet saying you have agreed to obey the rules
- 6. Parent's Sign up for Remind so I can send you updates and reminders and text you a few times while we are on the trip. (I don't plan on flooding you with texts, just a few important things). Text "@NashMT" to 81010
- 7. Girls/ guys buy appropriate length shorts for the trip (6inches from the knee, get a ruler if you need one, we have had problems with this in the past)

You have to have complete <u>all 7 steps</u> before you are officially registered for Nashville. The first 22 people who complete all 7 steps are registered for Nashville. We cannot accept any other people after that. We will have a waiting list for anyone else who completes all the steps (except for paying), if someone who is supposed to go drops out.
