These are the cornerstone events that we ask each of you to attend if possible: Men's Retreat, CHRISTeens, Women's Retreat, Spring Break Mission Trip, Nashville Mission Trip, 7th Grade Entry Banquet, Camp Caudle, Wilderness Trek, Back to school Lock-in, Summer SWEAT, Monday Night Bible Study, Winter Retreat, Sunday Morning Class, Wed Night class, Devotionals. Which of these have you participated in and what role did you play in these projects? *(If you have not been to hardly any these events then maybe you are not a leader!)* We also understand there are other ways to be involved in this youth ministry. Tell us about other ways you have been involved.

2. I want you to complete a short devotional book about leadership (it includes 3 devotionals). The devotional books are provided and are up in the Teen Center and at the Welcome Center. This will hopefully help you to develop and refine your leadership skills and also shows me you are serious about going on this trip. Once you complete them, put your name on them and put them in the mailbox in the Teen Center or behind the Welcome Center. There are no interviews this year, the devo books are replacing interviews.

3. If we have too many who sign up we might have to take additional steps to narrow those who go.
